



Wattle Glen Station Car Park

Early works – April 2022

The Victorian Government and Australian Government have partnered to deliver more commuter car parking for Wattle Glen Station. This will free up local streets and make it easier for passengers to catch the train.

Wattle Glen Station commuters will soon benefit from 50 new and upgraded parking spaces. New lighting, CCTV and bicycle hoops, will be installed to make it safer for commuters and more convenient for people to ride to the station and further ease pressure on car parking.

What to expect?

From early April, works will begin at the Wattle Glen Station car park and include set up of site sheds south of the current car park, installation of fencing and service locating.

How this will impact you

- The Southern section of the Station car park will be closed from 11 April.
- From the last service on Friday 15 April to the first service on Monday 18 April, the Wattle Glen Station and entire Station car park will be closed.
- The western shared use path between station entrance and the roundabout will be closed, with traffic management and signs to guide you safely around the work zone.
- Buses will replace trains from Clifton Hill to Hurstbridge from 8.30pm Friday 15 April to last service Sunday 17 April
- Temporary traffic management measures will be in place. However, access to your home or businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Some activity and construction noise may be noticeable, with vehicles moving around the area.

Hours of works

Planned out of hours work

From 9pm Monday 11 April to 7am Tuesday 12 April works will be taking place to remove and upgrade the kerb north of the roundabout on Main Hurstbridge Road.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane from 9pm. Traffic management and temporary lighting will be in place.

From 7pm Friday 15 April to 7am Monday 18 April crews will be working to install fencing, remove rail sleepers and service installation.

We will make every effort to mitigate the impact of our overnight construction activities and, where possible, schedule noisy and disruptive works during the day or early in the evening.
