

Tarneit Station Car Park

Major Works – May 2022

The Victorian Government's Car Parks for Commuters Program is building new and upgraded parking at stations across the state.

This will free up local streets and make it easier for passengers to catch the train. It will also increase safety with improved lighting and CCTV.

What to expect?

Construction on the new car parks, located east of the northern car park, and an upgrade to the current southern car park, will begin from early May and deliver 500 new spaces. Works will be completed by late 2022 and involve:

- Set up of temporary fencing to the east of the northern car park, with a site compound located within this area.
- Set up of temporary fencing to the south of the southern car park, with a site compound located within this area.
- Clearing of the vacant land, ground improvements, building pavement layers, asphaltting, line marking, installation of signage and landscaping.
- Construction of an additional 9 DDA spaces in the existing southern car park.

How this will affect you

- There will be car park closures at times throughout construction, please refer to signage in the area.
- You may notice some construction noise and activity with vehicles and workers moving around the area.
- Temporary traffic management measures may be in place in your immediate vicinity. However, access to your home or business will be maintained at all times.

Works will occur **Monday to Saturday**, between **7.00am** and **6.00pm**, with some weekend and out of hours works required at times.

Works on the Tarneit Station car park project are being carried out with COVIDSafe Plans in place to help protect workers and the community.
