

Wattle Glen Station car park – works update

Start of works and vegetation removal – May 2022

The Victorian Government’s Car Parks for Commuters Program is helping deliver 11,000 new and upgraded car parks at railway stations across the state.

Wattle Glen Station commuters will soon benefit from 50 new and upgraded parking spaces. New lighting, CCTV and bicycle hoops, will be installed to make it safer for commuters and more convenient for people to ride to the station and further ease pressure on car parking.

Works taking place

Over the coming months, works will include:

- Site establishment and construction of a laydown area.
- Vegetation removal to make way for new infrastructure. Once major construction is complete, more than 3100 plants and shrubs will be planted in the area.
- The western shared use path between the station entrance and the roundabout will remain closed until late 2022 with traffic management and signs to guide you safely around the work zone.

What to expect

- Intermittent out of hours works from **Sunday 22 May to Thursday 2 June** to install fencing near Wattle Glen Station while trains aren’t running.
- You may notice some construction noise and activity with vehicles and workers moving around the area.
- The western shared use path between the station entrance and the roundabout will remain closed until late 2022 with traffic management and signs to guide you safely around the work zone.
- Temporary traffic management measures may be in place. Access to residences and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Works will take place Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and Saturday between 8am and 3pm with some out of hours works required at times.

Vegetation

- We are working to reduce vegetation removal where possible, but some trees and vegetation will need to be removed to make way for the new car park.
- A qualified arborist and ecologist will be present to check for any fauna before any vegetation is removed and safely re homed if required. Where possible, mulch will be donated to local community groups.
- Once major construction is complete, more than 3100 seedlings, plants and shrubs will be planted in the area.
- Where possible, we will attempt to re-use or recycle trees that need to be removed.

Health and safety

Works on the Wattle Glen Station car park project are being carried out with COVIDSafe Plans in place to help protect workers and the community.
