

Caroline Springs Station car park

Early works – May to June 2022

The Victorian Government's Car Parks for Commuters Program is helping deliver 11,000 new and upgraded car parks at train stations across the state. This will free up local streets and make it easier for passengers to catch the train.

Commuters at Caroline Springs Station are set to experience more convenient journeys with 400 new and upgraded parking spaces, lighting and CCTV. Works start soon and the project will be complete in late 2022.

Works taking place

We're getting ready to build the new car parks at Caroline Springs Station. Over the coming months, works will include:

- site establishment, including installation of temporary fencing and site compound north of the current car park
- clearing vacant land and ground improvements
- vegetation removal to make way for new infrastructure. More than 3000 trees, plants and shrubs will be planted at the end of the project at different stages of maturity.

How this will affect you

- Works will occur **Monday to Friday**, between **7am** and **6pm**, and **Saturday 8am** to **3pm** with some weekend and out of hour's works required at times.
- There will be car park closures at times while we work, please refer to signage in the area.
- You may notice some construction noise and activity with vehicles and workers moving around the area.
- Temporary traffic management measures may be in place to help pedestrians and drivers move safely through the area.
