Night works and access changes: Friday 8 July – Monday 11 July

The Victorian Government's Car Parks for Commuters Program is helping deliver 11,000 new and upgraded car parks at train stations across the state. This will free up local streets and make it easier for passengers to catch the train. It will also increase safety with improved lighting and CCTV.

Yarraman Station commuters will soon benefit from 55 new and upgraded parking spaces. New lighting, CCTV and bicycle parking will be installed to make it safer for commuters and more convenient for people to ride to the station and further ease pressure on car parking.

Upcoming night works and access changes

We will work around the clock from **7pm Friday 8 July to 7am Monday 11 July** to complete critical works at Yarraman Station, while trains aren't running. Works will include:

- installation of temporary fencing around the work site
- saw cutting of asphalt on the station platform
- trenching to lay conduit for future underground services.

During this time, there will be changes to the way you access Yarraman Station, Hanna Street and walking and cycling trails in the area.

How this will impact you

- Yarraman Station will be closed. The pedestrian overpass and myki facilities will still be accessible.

- Buses will replace trains on the Cranbourne and Pakenham lines from 12am Saturday 9 July until last service on Sunday 10 July. Plan ahead at ptv.vic.gov.au
- Hanna Street will be closed and on street parking will be unavailable between **Wilkinson Street and the Eastlink Trail**. Traffic management and detour signs will guide you safely. All day parking will be available at Yarraman Station car park on Railway Parade (refer map below).
- You may notice some construction noise from machinery and vehicles, vibration and light. We will make efforts to mitigate the impact of our construction activities by scheduling noisy works during the day or earlier in the evening where possible.
