Merlynston Station car park – works update

August 2022

The Victorian Government and Australian Government have partnered to deliver more commuter car parking for Merlynston Station. This will help free up local streets and make it easier for passengers to catch the train. Commuters will soon benefit from new and upgraded parking spaces, new lighting, CCTV and more bicycle hoops. The project is also completing the missing link of the Upfield Bike Path along Bain Avenue.

What's happening

- Our site compound has been relocated to 8 Shorts Road to complete essential works in the new car park.
- Works continue on the eastern car park, with the first section of the car park and new bike parking facilities complete in the coming months. Access to the station from Bain Avenue will reopen.
- The remainder of the eastern car park and the connection of the Upfield bike path will be complete by the end of the year.
- The western car park will open next year.

What to expect

- Construction activity will progress from the northern section of the eastern car park, towards Shorts Road.
- You may notice increased noise, vibration and machinery on site. We aim to minimise impacts where possible.
- Site activity, including workers parking, light and low-level noise from **6.30am**. Works will take place between **7am and 6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and **between 7am and 6pm on Saturdays**, unless otherwise notified.
- Temporary traffic management may be in place while we work. Access to residences and businesses will be maintained at all times.
