

# Yarraman Station car park

## Night works: Monday 29 August

The Victorian Government's Car Parks for Commuters Program is helping deliver 11,000 new and upgraded car parks at train stations across the state. This will free up local streets and make it easier for passengers to catch the train. Yarraman Station commuters will soon benefit from 55 new and upgraded parking spaces, new lighting, CCTV and bicycle parking.

## What's happening

Works are progressing on the new car park at Yarraman Station, set to open before the end of the year.

During recent excavation works on Railway Parade, asbestos material has been identified and we're preparing to remove it in line with strict health and safety guidelines.

## Upcoming works

- To safely complete removal works, licensed professionals will be working out of hours from **7pm Monday 29 August to 7am Tuesday 30 August**.
- The asbestos material will be removed in line with EPA Guidelines, OH&S Regulations 2007, and WorkSafe Compliance Code for Removing Asbestos in the Workplace.
- Trenching works will also take place, to lay conduit for underground services.

## What to expect

- Up to 12 car parks along Railway Parade will be closed from **7am Sunday 28 August – 5pm Tuesday 30 August**.
- The pedestrian crossing on railway parade will be closed while we work, please follow signage for detour.
- Traffic management will be in place to help you move safely through the area.
- You may notice some construction noise from machinery and vehicles, vibration and light. We will make efforts to mitigate the impact of our construction activities where possible.
